Profits : The growth in SG&A ratio outpaced the gross profit margin, resulting in year-on-year declines across all profit levels

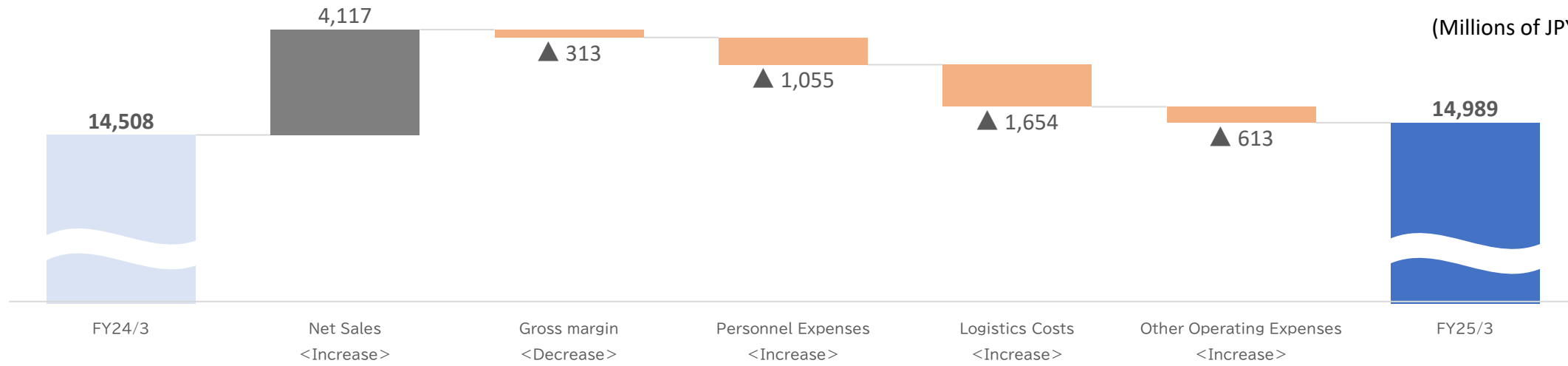

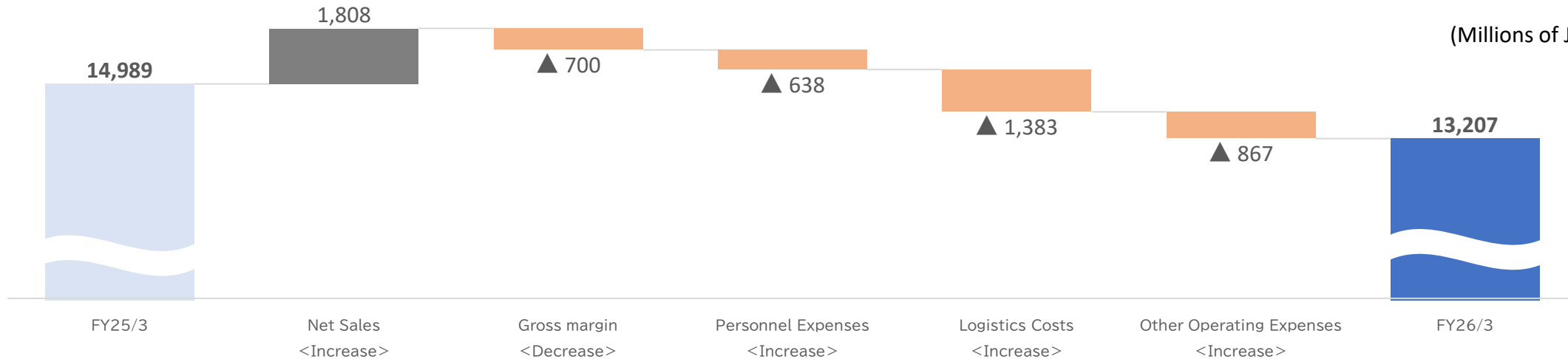
FY25/3 (Cumulative)

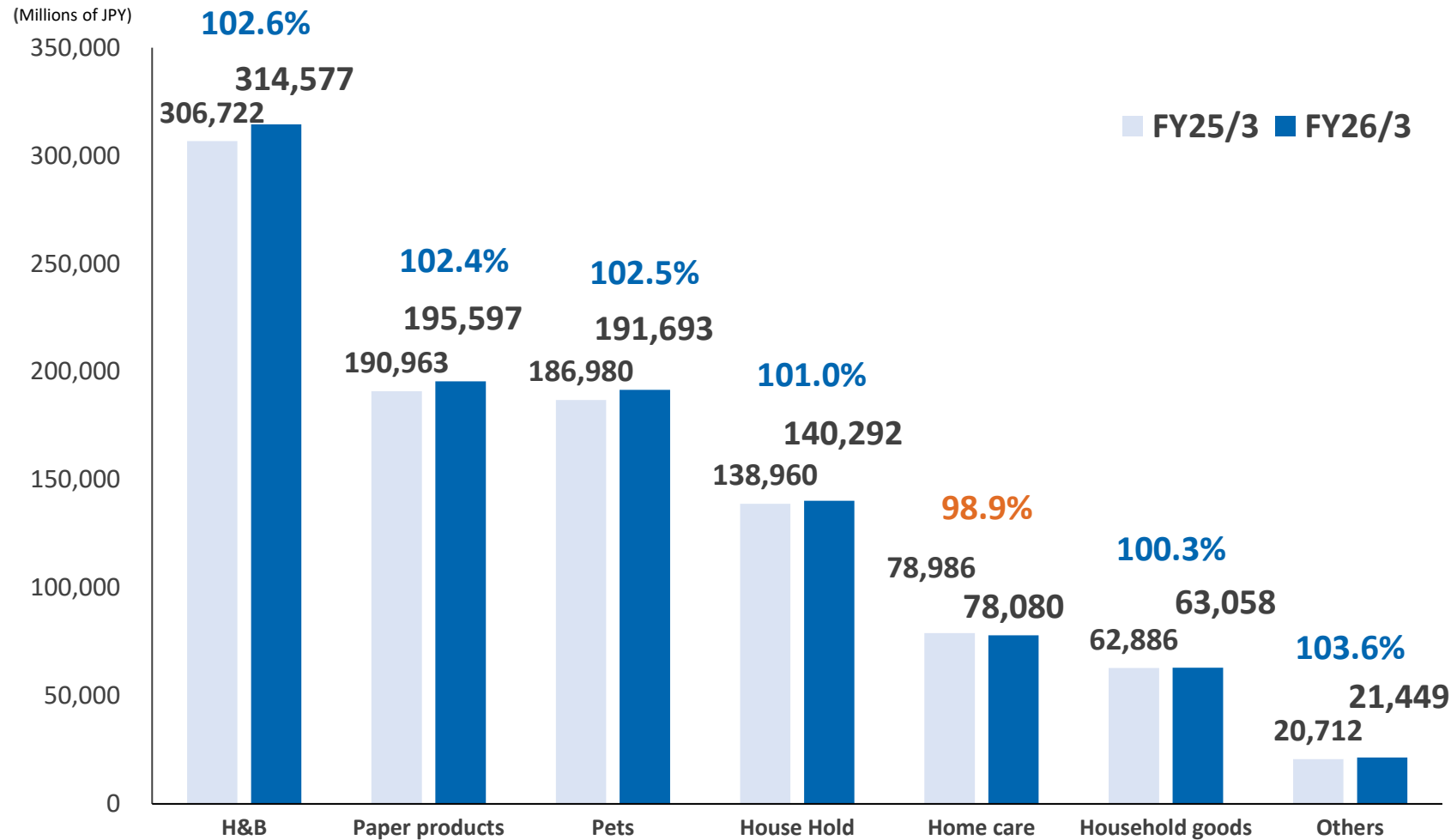

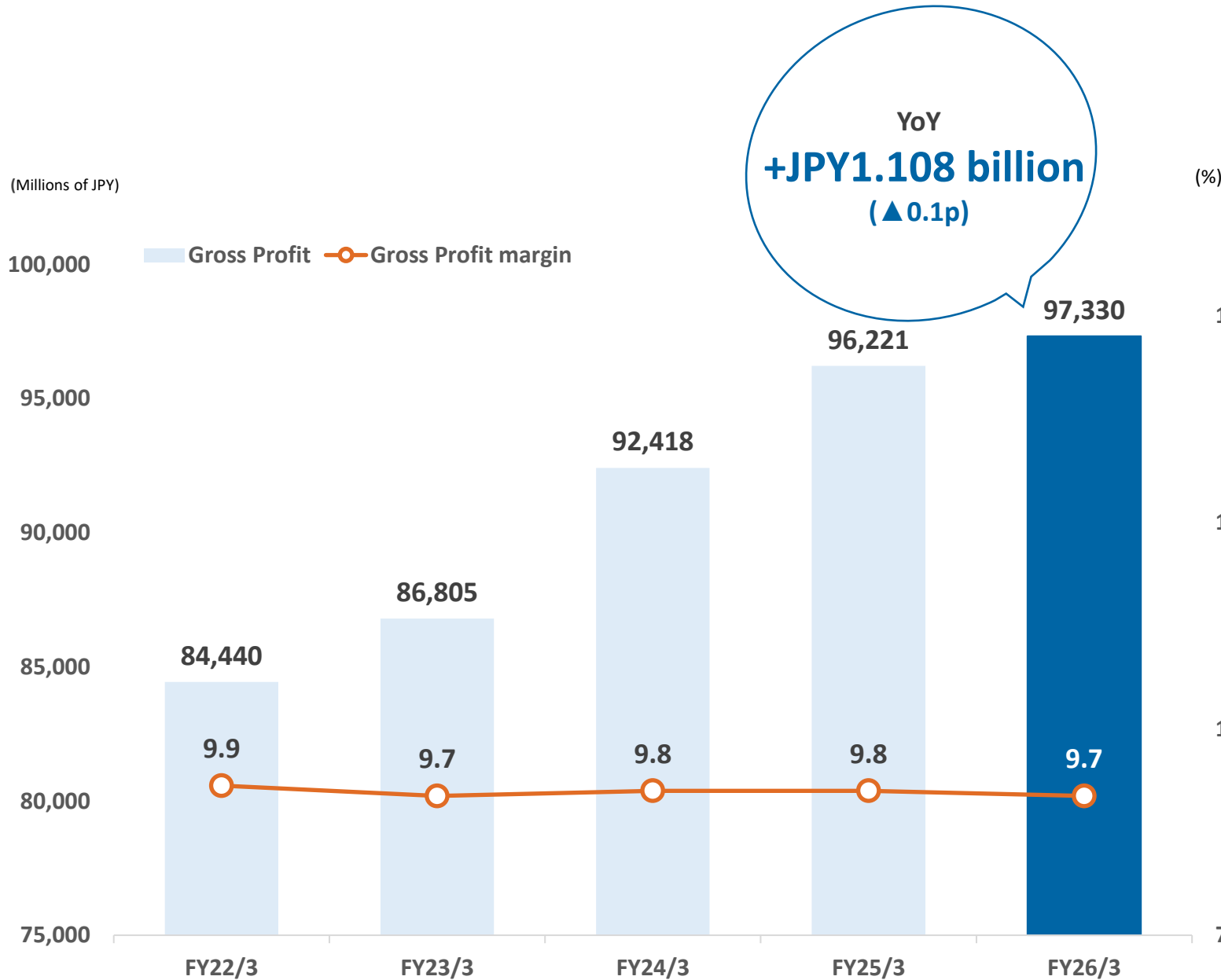

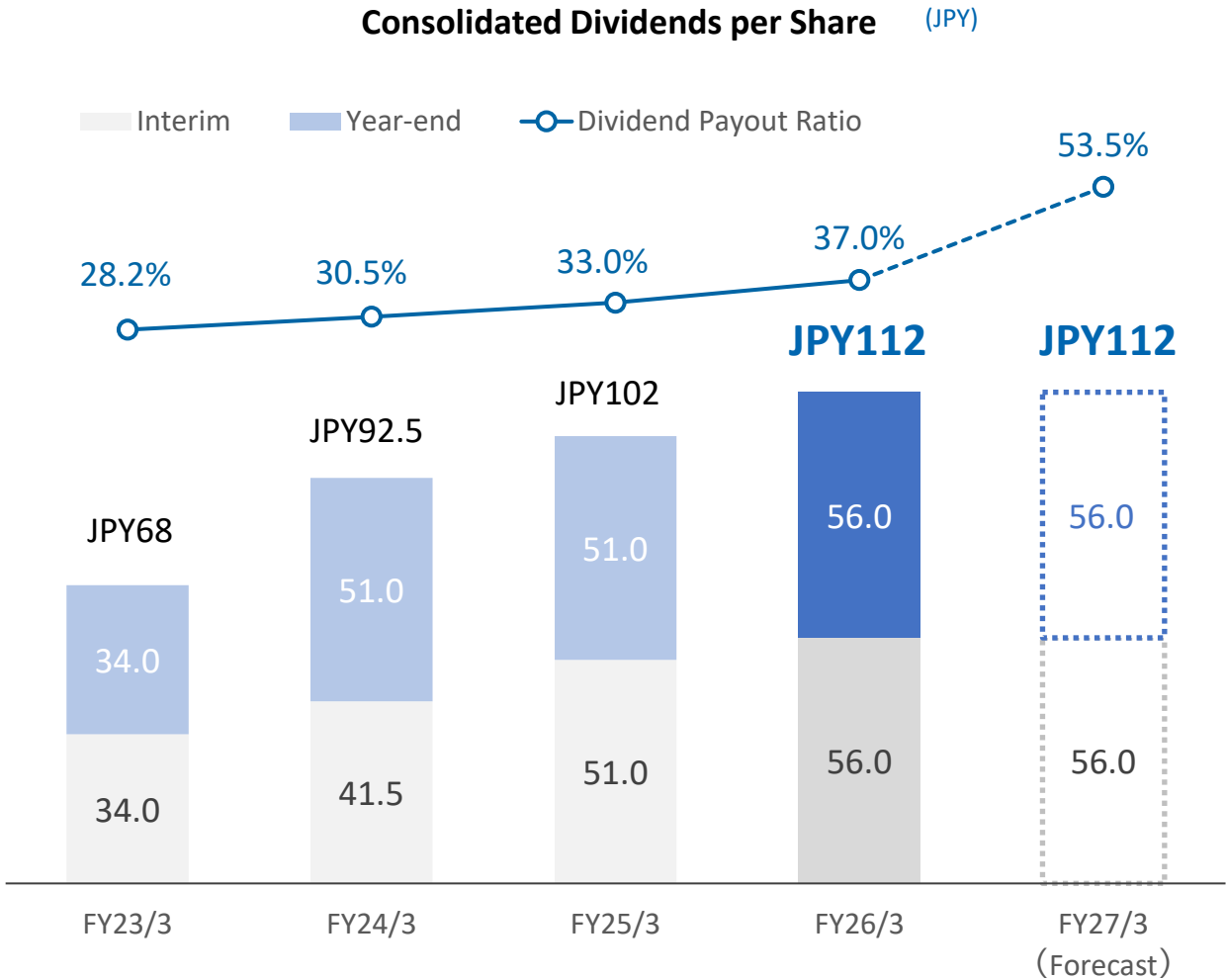
